SUNDAY 20th November 2011

Class 1 Intro Test A (2008) -no canter - Restricted to novice horses and riders who have not been placed 1st in an open dressage competition at Intro level or above- **HORSES AND RIDER COMBINATIONS IN THIS CLASS CANNOT ENTER CLASSES 3, 4, 5 OR 6. Open competition means those other than members only.**

Class 2 PRELIM 1 (2006) - Restricted to novice horses and riders not been placed 1st in an open dressage competition at Prelim level or above. **Open competition means those other than members only.**

Class 3 PRELIM 10 (2002) - Restricted to novice horses and riders not been placed 1st in an open dressage competition at Novice level or above. **Open competition means those other than members only.**

Class 4 NOVICE 24 (2010) - Open to all horse and riders.

Class 5 NOVICE 34 (2009) - Open to all horse and riders.

Class 6 ELEMENTARY 42 (2008) - Open to all horse and riders.

Class 1 Intro Test A (2008) -no canter - Restricted to novice horses and riders who have not been placed 1st in an open dressage competition at Intro level or above - **HORSES AND RIDER COMBINATIONS IN THIS CLASS CANNOT ENTER CLASSES 3, 4, 5 OR 6. Open competition means those other than members only.**

Class 2 PRELIM 4 (2002) -Restricted to novice horses and riders not been placed 1st in an open dressage competition at Prelim level or above. **Open competition means those other than members only.**

Class 3 PRELIM 13 (2006) - Restricted to novice horses and riders not been placed 1st in an open dressage competition at Novice level or above. **Open competition means those other than members only.**

Class 4 NOVICE 27 (2007) - Open to all horse and riders.

Class 5 NOVICE 30 (2006) - Open to all horse and riders.

Class 6 ELEMENTARY 44 (2002) - Open to all horses and riders

Class 1 Intro Test B (2009) -no canter - Restricted to novice horses and riders who have not been placed 1st in an open dressage competition at Intro level or above. - **HORSES AND RIDER COMBINATIONS IN THIS CLASS CANNOT ENTER CLASSES 3, 4, 5 OR 6. Open competition means those other than members only.**

Class 2 PRELIM 7 (2002) -Restricted to novice horses and riders not been placed 1st in an open dressage competition at Prelim level or above. **Open competition means those other than members only.**

Class 3 PRELIM 18 (2002) - Restricted to novice horses and riders not been placed 1st in an open dressage competition at Novice level or above. **Open competition means those other than members only.**

Class 4 NOVICE 28 (2008) - Open to all horse and riders.

Class 5 NOVICE 34 (2009) - Open to all horse and riders.

Class 6 ELEMENTARY 42 (2008) - Open to all horses and riders

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- **British dressage rules will apply to all classes – except BHS approved hat with straps must be worn. Gloves must be worn – light colour preferred**
- **Horses must be 4 years old and over to compete.**
- **Tests – as issued by 'British Dressage'**
- **Horses and rider combinations that enter class 1 will not be allowed to enter classes 3, 4, 5 at the same event**
- **Open event means those open to any competitor – not riding club members only events.**
- **Due to light restrictions numbers in classes may be limited.**
- **Riders compete at their own risk, Newcastle Riding Club or Lane Farm Equestrian takes no responsibility for any loss or damage which may take place at any of these events.**
- **Please ensure that horses are not left unattended whilst tied to Lorries or trailers. We recommend wagons and cars are locked.**
- **No skipping out in car park – take all rubbish home**
- **Please keep all dogs on a lead at all times and all poop to be scooped.**
- **Tests will take place in the indoor arena and warm up facilities will be in the outdoor arena.**
- **Entry fees are as follows: NRC Members £8.00. Non-members £10.00 per class. Late entries will only be accepted if numbers and time allow and will incur a £5.00 late entry fee.**
- **No refund of entry fees for withdrawals after the closing date.**
- **Please make cheques payable to 'Newcastle Riding Club'.**
- **Entries will close the Thursday prior to each competition.**
- **Times will be available on the website from 7:30 p.m the Friday prior to each competition or between 7.30pm and 9.30pm the Friday prior to each competition by telephoning – 01670 717018**
- **In all classes rosettes will be awarded to sixth place.**
- **Points will be awarded for each placing achieved in each class as follows:
1st – 6 points, 2nd – 5 points, 3rd – 4 points, 4th – 3 points, 5th – 2 points, 6th – 1 point.**

Wherever possible classes will be split into juniors and seniors and separate points will be awarded. However if there are minimal junior entries classes will not be split.

Overall Championship rosettes will be awarded to 6th place in the point's competition.

NRC member's trophy and championship rosettes to 6th place in the NRC member's only competition will also be awarded.
